Year 12 General Art

The Year 12 General Art students have been honing their drawing skills and delving into an activity called Fractured Portraits. They took their own self portrait photos and created unique viewfinders from card-stock. Using these viewfinders, they traced the final composition onto paper and then placed the viewfinder on top of their printed photos to aid in observational drawing. This creative approach to self portraits has been a fantastic learning experience, and it's delightful to witness the progress of our Year 12 General Art students! Such a great success.



Year 10 AEP HASS - Law Society Incursion

The Year 10 AEP HASS classes enjoyed an interactive presentation from some Murdoch University law students last week as part of the Street Law community outreach legal program. Students learnt about a developing area of environmental law which may see governments held responsible and holding a duty of care towards young people if they approve of mining and development projects which harm the environment (for example significantly contributing to carbon emissions). Students worked collaboratively in groups to debate a proposed bill on the topic.

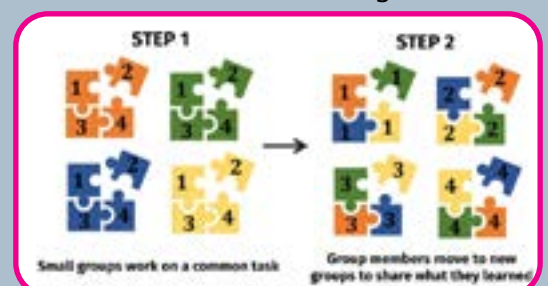
- Activating Students as Learning Resources for One Another -

Example 2 - Jigsaw

The jigsaw strategy is a strategy used in class to activate students as learning resources for one another. This collaborative learning approach divides students into expert groups, with each group responsible for becoming experts on a specific topic or concept.

After thorough exploration and discussion in this group, each member of the expert group joins a new group composed of members with different expertise. Group members share their newfound expertise and gain valuable knowledge from the other experts. In this process, students teach and learn from their peers, enhancing their understanding of the subject matter collectively.

The jigsaw strategy not only deepens students' knowledge but also promotes teamwork, critical thinking, and active participation, making it an effective tool for empowering students to contribute to one another's learning experiences.
