

## Dear Parent / Guardians

The National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is held for students in Year 7 and 9 in high school. From 2023 the NAPLAN assessment is held in March. Churchlands SHS staff are currently coordinating the effective implementation of the assessment protocols.

Students with a diagnosed disability, medical condition, mental health condition and/or learning difficulty receive adjustments for NAPLAN specific to their diagnosis. These adjustments may include extra working time, rest breaks, assistive technology etc. The school has received documentation through the enrolment process for some students and will apply for adjustment as appropriate. However, the school would like to request families who may not have provided this information from the enrolment form to please forward diagnosis documentation to the school by close of business by Friday 21 February either via email or dropped off to the front office. Unfortunately, the school can not apply for adjustments without diagnosis documentation which may impact your child's ability to access NAPLAN on the same basis as their peers.
